As part of future training days I have made this simple board to help teach people all about anchors and the many different situations, depending on the activity.

Whether it's climbing, canyoning, or caving, almost any situation can be simulated on this board. It's made from 16mm ply with 3/8 bolts and T-nuts & cost \$30.00, including the chain, snaplinks & maillons.

These are great if you want to practice rigging in a safe way at home, or just about anywhere.
